With the aim of getting to Net Zero on carbon dioxide, switching to renewable raw materials, moving to reusable and recyclable packaging and for materials going to drain to have no environmental impact. There is consensus that we need to do this and do it fast, but what does this mean in practice?

Leading industry speakers will give their expert insight, starting with a keynote on what the world should look like by 2030 and how the EU Green Deal lays down a vision for Europe. We investigate certifications for green products but also how not to fall into greenwashing traps.

Post lunch we take a look at raw materials from natural sources and the challenges they pose, followed by a key ingredient supplier showing their journey and what lies ahead. Finally, all products come in packaging and we'll find out what is happening to make these green.
